Admission Criteria:

- Males 12-17 Years of Age Upon Admission
- Possession of a Mental Illness
- Adjudicated as Delinquent
- Full Scale IQ of 68 or Greater
- Youths With IQ's of 50-68 Are Individually Assessed for Appropriateness

Security:

- Closed Medium/High Secure Facility
- 24 Hour Staff Supervision
- Electronic Monitoring and Surveillance
- Continual Crisis Intervention and Suicide Prevention Monitoring
