Admission Criteria:

- Males between the ages of 12-17 upon admission
- Possession of a mental illness with an Axis I diagnosis
- Adjudicated as delinquent
- Full Scale IQ of 68 or above
- Youths with IQ's between 50-68 are individually assessed for appropriateness
